



Speaking Contest Event Guidelines

Fall Leadership Conference 2018

Purpose: To provide secondary members an opportunity to present their “elevator speech” answering the question, “What is HOSA?”

Procedures During the presentation, competitors must be in the HOSA Uniform Attire (see [Georgia HOSA Dress Code](#) for more information) and will have a maximum of 30 seconds to present their speech to a panel of judges. Presentation time slots will be given at Fall Leadership Conference Check-In.

Participants must register to participate via the Conference Registration in the HOSA Affiliation System for the Fall Leadership Conference. Each school may submit one (1) student for this event.

Regulations:

1. Competitors must be current secondary members of HOSA.
2. Competitors must be in HOSA Uniform Attire during event.
3. Competitors are only allowed to participate in one event at the Fall Leadership Conference.
4. Information provided during the speech must be current and accurate.
5. Speech must be delivered within the time limit (maximum of 30 seconds).
6. Speech must answer the question, What is HOSA?
7. Competitors must be registered via the Conference Registration in the HOSA Affiliation System for the Fall Leadership Conference in order to participate in this event.
