



Build a Hospital

Materials Needed

- ✓ Typing paper or plain white construction paper
- ✓ Rulers
- ✓ Computer / Internet / Classroom book
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Notebook paper

Students will draw the layout/design of a hospital, while meeting the following criteria:

- Each hospital will need the following departments:
 - Admissions
 - Cleaning / Housekeeping
 - Emergency Room
 - Intensive Care Unit (ICU)
 - Laboratory
 - Maternity Department
 - Pediatrics
 - Pharmacy
 - Radiology Department
 - Surgical Department
- Students are required to add a minimum of 3 more departments of their chose.
- The hospital must be at least 2 stories high.
- Other areas of the hospital to consider:
 - Cafeteria
 - Chapel
 - Waiting Rooms
 - Health Education rooms
 - Gift shop
 - Main Entrance
- Students will need to put into writing an explanation of their design. 150-200 words. Needs to include visiting hours, number of beds in the hospital, what happens in each department, what medical professions are needed, and where they would choose to work within their hospital.

***These lesson plans could also serve as part of your lesson plan for Monday, March 16, 2015, when you return from SLC. The students may or may not need time to complete the assignments, if so, allow them to continue. You could also have the students present their discoveries/breakthroughs and/or hospitals to the class, and allow this to create discussion between you and the students.*

***If you are in the middle of a specific unit and would like to stay on track, just re-word these assignments to match the unit. (Ex: Infection Control = research medical discoveries that specifically involve infection control precautions or add isolation areas to their hospitals to prevent the spread of disease)*
