



Mock Interview (Middle School) Event Guidelines

Fall Leadership Conference

Purpose: For Middle School HOSA members to participate in a mock interview to gain interviewing experience.

Procedures: Each Middle School chapter may submit 2 members to participate in this event. Competitors will meet with a panel of judges and interview for a mock officer position on their chapter's leadership team. The competitor will need to decide, before the interview, which officer position they are "applying" for. The dress code for this event is the HOSA Uniform Attire (please refer to the [Georgia HOSA Dress Code](#) for more information). Each interview will be a maximum of 3 minutes.

Participants must register to participate via the Conference Registration in the HOSA Affiliation System for the Fall Leadership Conference. Each school may register 2 members.

Regulations:

1. The competitor must be a Middle School HOSA member.
2. The competitor must be in HOSA Uniform Attire.
3. Competitors are only allowed to participate in one event at the Fall Leadership Conference.
4. Competitors must be registered via the Conference Registration in the HOSA Affiliation System for the Fall Leadership Conference in order to participate.
